

First Aid

As a school, your child's safety is very important to us. We therefore have a large number of first aid trained staff and have recently invested in a new first aid room.

We are at present creating a new first aid policy to take into account these improved facilities and additional first aid equipment that we have invested in, such as the automated external defibrillator (AED).

When any member of staff administers first aid it is recorded in the school's first aid books and a tear off sheet for parents is created. Depending on the age of the child this is either handed over to the adult who picks them up (FS2 or KS1 children) or placed in their book bag (KS2 children) and where applicable following the new policy parents/carers will be contacted by phone.
