On each day the children will continue with normal learning activities in the afternoon.

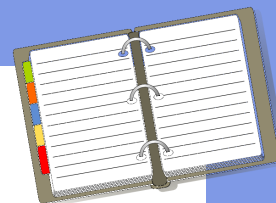
Year 6 Leaver's Assembly
