The day will be organised in the following way:

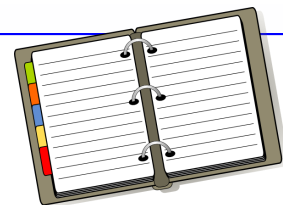

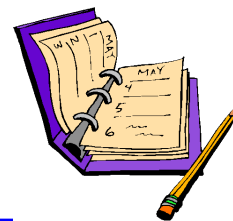
